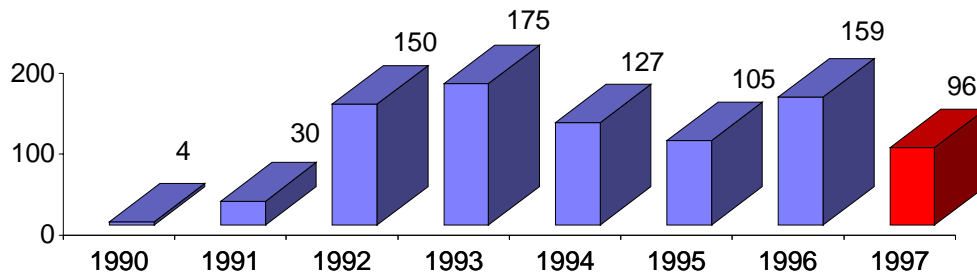

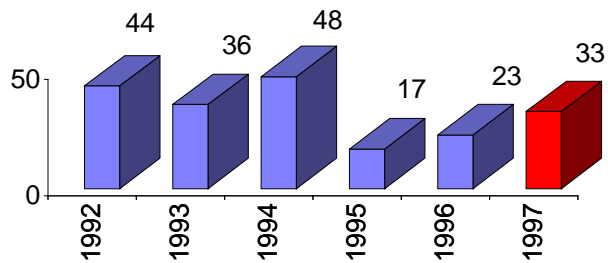

**ARREST COUNTS BY COUNTY**



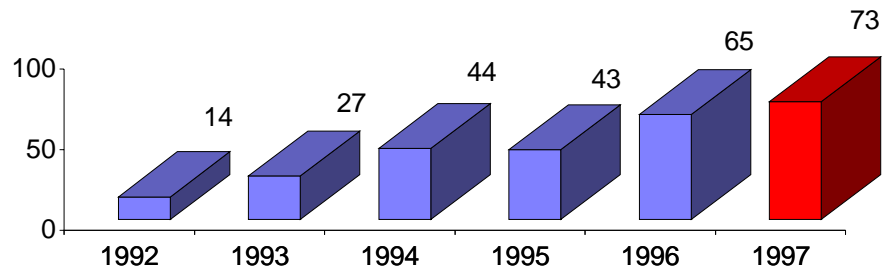

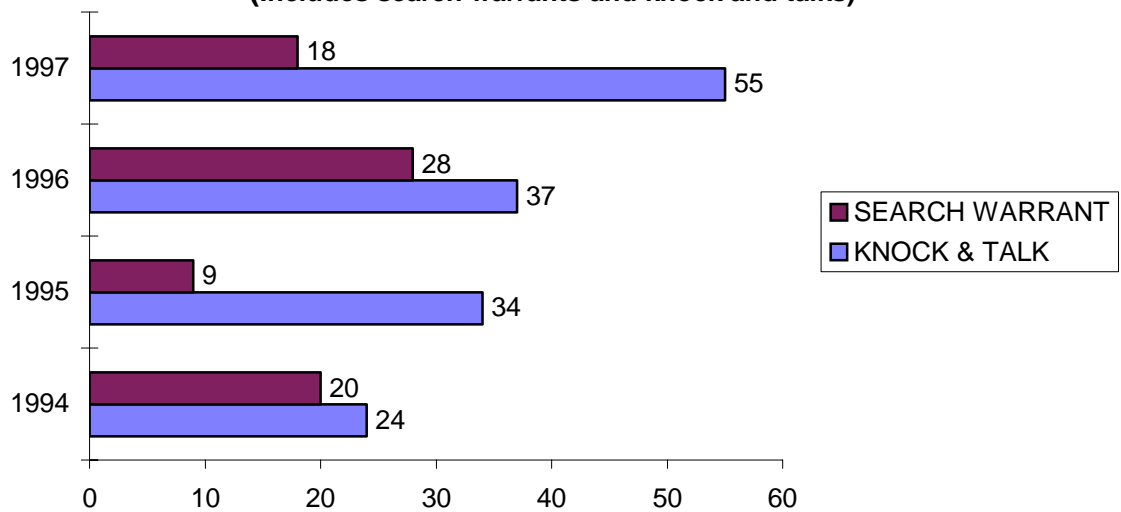

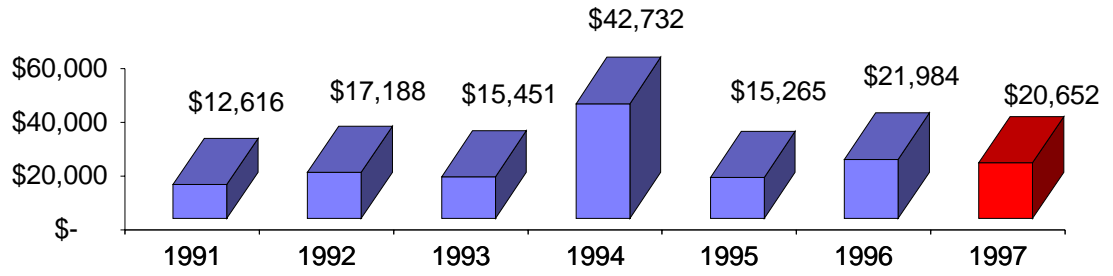

(Includes search warrants and knock and talks)

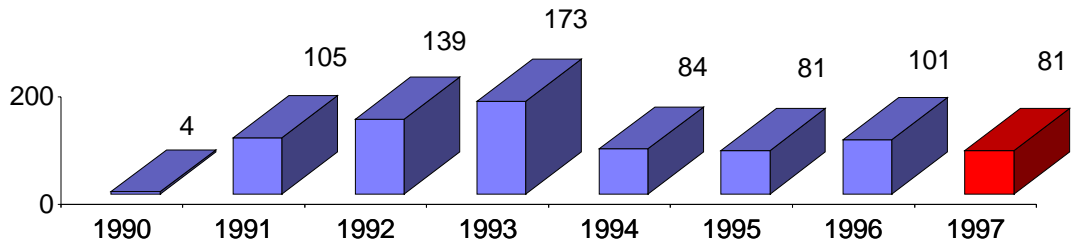
